The Mill Valley Fire Department serves approximately 14,000 people with two fire stations, and responds to approximately 2000 calls for service annually. The City of Mill Valley is located 11 miles north of the Golden Gate Bridge and San Francisco and encompasses the hillsides and canyons of the southeast flank of 2,571-foot Mount Tamalpais. In addition to firefighting and emergency medicine the Mill Valley Fire Department members are specialized in a wide range of skills including fire investigations, technical rescue, working with Community Emergency Response Teams, CPR and first aid instruction.
