SASM & SD5 Agreement

Jill Barnes presented a draft of the agreement with SD5 that will allow for the extension of the terms of the expired agreement between SASM and SD5 until February of 2014. President Kious stated that he had a preliminary phone conversation with SD5 board president Cathy Benediktsson and both parties agreed that it a reasonable approach pending the completion of the study of the vulnerabilities of the existing deep water outfall.

Staff will continue to work with SD5 staff to develop a comprehensive agreement.
