NOTICE OF MILL VALLEY PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER AMENDING THE DOWNTOWN PLAZA ORDINANCE

The Parks and Recreation Commission entertained public comment at the July 13th, 2011 meeting and is seeking further public input in assisting to evaluate and make a recommendation to the City Council on amending the Downtown Plaza ordinance. The Community has shown interest in expanding the use of the Plaza. Allowing additional amplified music performances, community events, and larger special events will be some of the modification discussed at the public hearing. No physical changes to the Plaza will be heard or considered.

The Parks & Recreation Commission will consider public input obtained prior to and at the hearing at which time the Commission will make its recommendation to the Council for potential changes to the Downtown Plaza ordinance.
