Al Grumet – commented regarding Climate Action Plan – BPAC should identify/coordinate/sync bike projects/issues with CIP projects.

Jared – Bike Parking Assessment will be ready/discussed at next BPAC meeting

Re: Millwood/Dell business/resident parking – based on survey/collected data, business owners in the area strongly favor keeping on-street parking. DPW recommends keeping on-street parking in lieu of proposed bike left-turn queue on shoulder, and study further for alternative solutions which limit on-street parking removal. Shoulder striping between Thalia and Carmelita will be incorporated into the East Blithedale pavement striping plan.

Bike signs at Depot Plaza targeted for early April.

Staff looking into removal of unpermitted awning posts along sidewalk near Peet's

David – comments that Streets Smarts sign program is targeted for April. Samples and proposed locations were shown.
