

ORDINANCE NO. 93-1  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 92-1  
PERTAINING TO AGENCY ANNUAL SEWER SERVICE CHARGES  
SEWERAGE AGENCY OF SOUTHERN MARIN

IT IS ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Sewerage Agency of Southern Marin, as follows:

Section 1. Exhibit "B" to Ordinance No. 92-1, "An Ordinance Establishing and Prescribing Sewer Service Charges", is amended in its entirety in the form attached to this Ordinance, which is incorporated by reference.

Section 2. Except as amended by this Ordinance, Ordinance No. 92-1 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), Public Resources §21,000 et seq. and the regulation promulgated pursuant to CEQA ("the State Guidelines") the Board of Commissioners finds that this Ordinance establishes and modifies rates and charges for the purposes of meeting operating expenses of the Agency, meeting financial reserve needs and requirements of the Agency and/or obtaining funds for capital projects which are necessary to maintain services within existing service areas in the Agency. (State Guidelines §15273).

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be entered in full upon the minutes of the meeting of the Board at which it was approved and adopted, shall be published once in the Mill Valley Record, a newspaper of general circulation published in the Agency, and shall take effect upon expiration of the week of publication.
